#### **General Purpose**

Under the supervision of the General Administrator, the Health Transport Operations and Fleet Manager supervises and coordinates Health Transport Services (HTS) and fleet maintenance for the Health Transportation Division.

## **Essential Duties and Responsibilities**

The duties and responsibilities listed below are intended to provide a representative list of various types of work that may be performed. Specifications are not intended to reflect all duties performed within the job class, and incumbent may expect to perform other related similar duties.

The Health Transport Manager is responsible for overseeing the Health Transport Division staff and fleet maintenance while ensuring that customers and clients receive the highest degree of courtesy and professionalism. Oversight it carried out in compliance with Southern Cascades CSD policies and procedures.

### **Responsibilities**

- Coordinate and manage HTS personnel
- Perform personnel reviews
- Oversite and recruitment of HTS personnel
- · Set standards for productivity and efficiency improvement
- Ensure safety standards and practices are in place

- Facilitate routine vehicle maintenance
- Maintain accurate and updated vehicle maintenance log
- Assist in long term planning for the division
- Enforcement of District policies and standards
- Dispatch Health Transport trips
- Ability to train HTS drivers on health transport workflow and expectations
- Monitoring and approval of health transport personnel timekeeping records
- Provide excellent customer service skills to patients, clients, members, co-workers, persons of other agencies and the public
- Ensure all vehicles are stocked with appropriate supplies
- Ensure all vehicles are clean and in safe operating condition
- Promote District services within the community and surrounding areas
- Utilize phone, computer, or other electronic devices as required
- Ability to carry out basic or routine vehicle maintenance

#### **Physical Task and Environmental Conditions**

Employees must meet the following requirements, which are necessary to successfully perform the essential functions of this position. Essential job tasks are defined as follows:

- Independent lift and carry 50 pounds.
- Lift one end of a patient laden gurney from mid-level to high level.
- Ability to operate office equipment such as a computer, printer, scanner, and fax machine
- Manual dexterity necessary to perform small equipment and vehicle repairs including but not limited to; headlights, fuses, sensors, change tires, etc.

Communicate orally and by telephone with management, co-workers, and the public in face to face, one to one, and group settings; use office equipment such as computers and stand or walk for extended periods of time.
